



## TOWNSHIP OF PERRY BURNING BY-LAW REGULATIONS



### BURNING GRASS

You can burn areas of grass or leaf litter on land you lawfully occupy or give permission to burn grass and leaf litter on land you lawfully occupy, without a fire permit, provided you meet all of the following conditions:

- The fire is only allowed if the Perry Fire Department and/or the Ministry of Natural Resources have not declared a **TOTAL FIRE BAN**. (Check with your Municipal Office)
- From November 1<sup>st</sup> and until March 31<sup>st</sup> burning may be permitted in the daytime.
- **NO DAY TIME BURNING From April 1<sup>st</sup>. to October 31<sup>st</sup>** a fire is only allowed to burn from between the hours of **6.00pm.** in the evening to **10.00am** in the morning.
- The total area to be burned does not **exceed one hectare. (2.5 Acres)**
- **The flaming edge** of the fire **does not exceed 30 meters (100ft) in length.**
- **A responsible person** tends the fire until it is extinguished.
- You have **adequate tools and water** to contain the fire to the fire site.
- The **property owner** is still **liable** if the fire is not contained.
